## Reviewing process and publication

The extended abstract will then undergo a review process by a member of the scientific committee for final approval.

Authors and reviewers will exchange directly **between the 6th and the 29<sup>th</sup> of April 2020**. The reviewers' corrections and comments on the extended abstract must be taken into account for final approval by the scientific committee.

The text will be published in the Proceedings of the conference when at least one of the authors has paid his **registration fees by May 15, 2020** at the latest.

A participant may present several abstracts (oral or poster) during the conference (yet one as first author) knowing that each abstract presented is subject to payment of registration fees.
